

#### TRINITY SUNDAY

Each year, on the Sunday after Pentecost, we celebrate **Trinity Sunday.** The mystery of the Trinity has been the pulse of the Church's life since the very beginning. The whole of the Church's life flows from the central belief that the one true God exists as three divine persons – Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In revealing Himself as Trinitarian, God hasn't merely shared impersonal facts about Himself; rather, God has shared Himself with us, and has invited us in to His own inner life and communion of love – which alone is the origin, goal and meaning of our life. On Trinity Sunday the Church proclaims the truth about God – that God is love, and the truth about us: we are made for this love. We eternally belong to God – we have an eternal home!


