GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION (April 7)

<u>Our Parish</u>, once a year on Good Friday, is called on to support Christians in the Holy Land. Many Christians in the Holy Land depend on this collection for their lives.

A Pontifical Collection, requested by the Pope, the "Annual Good Friday Collection" offers a direct link for parishioners to be witnesses of peace and to help protect the Holy Places. When you donate on Good Friday, you are supporting Christians in the Holy Land.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE: On Good Friday, you are required to fast and abstain (age 18-59). Fasting means that you eat only one meal in a day with no food in between. It is understood the other two meals, if one eats three meals a day, should not total one full meal. To abstain is to not eat meat. Its purpose is to be an act of penance – an act of sacrifice. The Church encourages you to try to fast and abstain through sunset on Holy Saturday.




